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## MACOMB INTERCEPTOR SEWER REPAIRS PROJECT UPDATE JANUARY 2008

The Detroit Water and Sewerage Department and NTH Consultants have selected Inland Waters Pollution Control as the contractor to perform the Macomb County Sewer System Repairs Project. Based on the current schedule and project status, the project should be completed by the end of September 2008 and is currently approximately 48 percent complete.

During the month of January 2008, work consisted of performing sewer surface preparation in the sewer in an area west of Garfield Road in preparation for water proofing treatment. Construction of a large flow control structure into the sewer has also been on-going on Garfield Road just north of 15 Mile Road. During January, excavation and bracing has been completed to a depth of approximately 20 feet. Excavation and bracing installation in this area will continue through approximately May with heavy construction equipment and cranes. The northbound curb lane of Garfield Road is closed for this construction.

Along with continued work at the flow control structure, in February 2008, the contractor is planning to complete surface treatment in the sewer area west of Garfield Road. Generally, only traffic warning signs will be used at that location, however, some temporary lane closures will be conducted.

Flow control measures consist of raising and lowering a steel plate in the Garfield Gate and shutting down the Clintondale Pumping Station during daylight hours, which have not affected the public as the station is turned back on before flows become high.

DWSD will provide monthly written updates as appropriate throughout the repair period to keep all property and community members fully informed of the progress.
