REPLACEMENT OF BELT FILTER PRESSES FOR COMPLEX I AND UPPER LEVEL COMPLEX II

1. Bids – The City of Detroit, Michigan will receive sealed Bids for the Work delivered to the Detroit Finance Department, **Purchasing Division, Rm. #1008 Coleman A. Young Municipal Center**, Two Woodward Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226, until **2:00 P.M.**, local time, on **Thursday, October 20, 2011**, when all Bids duly received will be opened publicly and read aloud. Prior to arriving at the Coleman A. Young Municipal Center, proposers should review the **Security Memo** contained in **Section 00325** from the Purchasing Division.

2. Project Description - The Work, DWSD Wastewater Treatment Plant, Replacement of Belt Filter Presses for Complex I and Upper Level Complex II, **Contract No. PC-787** includes, but is not necessarily limited to replacement of 22 belt filter presses at the DWSD Wastewater Treatment Plant Sludge Dewatering Complexes with new belt filter presses, related belt conveyors, installation of new screw conveyors, replacement of catwalks, handrails and guard rails with new, replacement of sludge dewatering polymer feed systems, related belt filter press and polymer electrical systems, instrumentation and controls work, replacement and improvement of building mechanical systems, power distribution systems, construction of new control rooms, providing miscellaneous improvements, demolition work, abatement of asbestos-containing materials, lead-based paint and RCRA hazardous materials, coordination with owner's operations, construction sequencing, record drawings, O&M manuals, startup, commissioning, training, mobilization, demobilization, cleanup, management and closeout.

3. Bidding Documents - Beginning **Thursday, September 8, 2011**, Sets of Bidding Documents may be obtained from the **DWSD Contracts Section, 1504 Water Board Building, 735 Randolph**, Detroit, MI 48226 on Business Days between the hours of **8:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M.** Electronic copies may be obtained upon the payment of **\$100.00 per set**, in the form of a **certified or cashier's check made payable to the Detroit Board of Water Commissioners (which will not be refunded)**.

Bidding Documents will be shipped only if the requesting party assumes responsibility for all related charges.

4. Bid Security – Each Bid shall enclose Bid Security, as specified in the Instructions to Bidders (and **Section 00310**, Bid Bond), in the amount of **five percent (5%)** of the Bidder's Bid.

5. Pre-Bid Conference and Site Tour - A pre-bid conference will be held at the Water Board Building, **Room 1606**, 735 Randolph, Detroit, MI 48226, on **Tuesday, September 20, 2011 at 2:00 P.M.**, local time. Addenda may be issued, in response to issues raised at the pre-bid conference or as the **DWSD** and/or **Contracting Officer** may otherwise consider necessary.

6. Local Contracting Requirements – Local requirements applicable to this contract are reproduced in their entirety and available for review on the Detroit Water and Sewerage Department's website: www.dwsd.org. Potential Bidders are specifically directed to review requirements of this contract before submitting their bid. **Please be advised that DWSD will not accept joint ventures on this project. Note: Prevailing Wage Rates must be updated and paid each year by the contractor and subcontractors for the duration of the contract.**

7. Contract Times – The Contract Times are specified in **Exhibit A**, General Description of Work and Project. The associated **liquidated damages** are specified in **Article IV, Paragraph 4.02 of the Agreement**.

8. Award – Subject to any agreed extension of the period for holding Bids, Bids shall be open for acceptance by the **DWSD** for **180 days** after the date of Bid opening. In addition, the DWSD expressly reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive any non-conformances, to issue post-Bid Addenda and re-Bid the Work without re-advertising, to re-advertise for Bids, to withhold the award for any reason the **DWSD determines** and/or to take any other appropriate action.
