DWSD Sewer Repairs Project Update

The Detroit Water And Sewerage Department (DWSD) and NTH Consultants have selected Inland Waters Pollution Control as the contractor to perform the Macomb County Sewer System Repairs Project. The project has officially begun with substantial completion scheduled for August 2008.

Installation of a temporary work platform in the 11-foot sewer from a manhole on the south side of 15 Mile Road has been completed. The platform will be used for grouting operations behind the sewer liner in this area. Manhole restoration work on both shoulders of 15 Mile Road between Garfield and Jefferson Avenue has also been performed. Temporary curb lane closures and shoulder lane closures were utilized to accomplish this work.

Work continues at the Clintondale Pumping Station but is not expected to affect the public. Traffic warning signs will be utilized when necessary.

Work for August will consist of long-term closures of the northbound curb lane of Garfield Road just north of 15 Mile Road. Temporary lane closures will also occur at the eastbound curb lane of 15 Mile Road just west of Garfield. Pavement removal will be necessary for construction in both of these areas.

Due to the nature of the work, the proposed repairs will be performed mostly during nighttime hours, 7 days per week. The scheduled repairs are anticipated to take 12 months to complete. However, weather will be a factor due to flow conditions inside the sewer. Therefore, the total project duration is an estimate at this time.

DWSD will provide monthly written updates as appropriate throughout the repair period to keep all property and community members fully informed of the progress.
